Candidates should have strong communication skills and be able to provide leadership role for the Department as well as nurture it to an enviable height, among

others. The successful candidate would report directly to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).

(ii). JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Advise the CEO on Statistics, Economic Modeling, Statistical Computing and Data Management issues.
- Ensure timely compilation, analysis, and dissemination of statistics produced at the centre
- Supervise the conduct of quantitative and qualitative surveys, including Opinion Polls
- Guide statistical computing and data management processes within the centre
- Organise trainings on statistical methodologies and modeling procedures, as well as the compilation of statistics related to the four major macroeconomic accounts
- Organise trainings on the suite of Microsoft Office packages, CPro, SPSS, STATA, EViews, GAMS, GIS, R, Python, etc
- Guide Statistical Research and engage in active Statistical Advocacy and the running of the Statistics Clinic
- Ensure that all the research publications of the Centre are published in a timely manner

The successful candidate would report directly to the Chief Executive Officer (CEO).

- Monitor and analyse developments in the four macroeconomic sectors
- In particular, monitor and analyse monetary and fiscal trends to determine their level of complementarity.
- Watch developments and analyse movements in Nigeria's financial market indicators
- Benchmark CASEM's data outputs to existing data sets to ensure analytical integrity
- Conduct in-depth studies including macroeconomic impact analysis
- Conceptualise and sharpen the Centre's focus on macroeconomic policies
